## **SOLO COMPETITIONS**

All recording round material is unaccompanied.

Recording round postmark deadline is November 2, 2009 and must be received by November 7, 2009.

### Junior Soloist Competition (up to grade 8)

- Recording Round: #4 Birds of a Feather from Assorted Images by Jessica Kozlowski
- Final Round: Polonaise from Suite in bm by J.S. Bach (included in 24 Short Concert Pieces)

### High School Soloist Competition (grades 9 - 12)

- Recording Round: Gypsy Dance by L.E. Carter
- Final Round: 1) Winter Spirits by Katherine Hoover and 2) Fantasy by Faure

### Collegiate Artist Competition (undergraduates only)

- Recording Round: Density 21.5 by Varese
- Final Round: 1) 3 Pieces by Ferroud and 2) Waltz from Suite Op 116 by Godard

### Young Artist Competition (age 30 or younger as of January 16, 2009)

- Recording Round: 3 Preludes Op 18 by Muczynski
- Final Round: 1) Four Lyric Pieces by John Heiss and 2) Nocturne and Allegro Scherzando by Gaubert

Up to three finalists in each category will be selected to compete on January 15, 2010.  
At the judges' discretion, the First Prize winner in each category will perform at the Festival.  
Previous First Prize winners are ineligible to compete in the same category.

## **CONCERTO COMPETITION**

Recording round postmark deadline is November 2, 2009 and must be received by November 7, 2009.

**Concerto in C Major, opus 7, no. 3 by Jean-Marie Leclair (complete)**

The winner of the Concerto Competition will be selected from the recorded applications. The recording must include piano (reduction) accompaniment. The winner of the Concerto Competition will perform with the Campbellsville University String Ensemble during the 2010 KY Flute Festival and will need to be present in Campbellsville, KY as early as January 14, 2010 for rehearsals.
